Delaware overall ranked 11th but has the highest air quality.

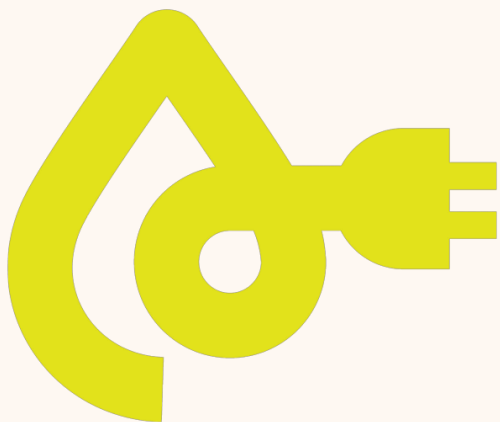
California registered the highest water quality
