Overview

Join us for a roundtable discussion among practitioners and thought leaders working on the youth agenda to co-create the PROSPECTS4Youth Intergenerational Network¹, designed to advance young people's engagement, education, skills development, and employment in forced displacement contexts. The roundtable will explore collaborative solutions and mobilise collective action that can support young people in forced displacement contexts realise their true potential.

ILO, UNHCR, and UNICEF are jointly establishing the PROSPECTS4Youth Intergenerational Network (IGN) that connects PROSPECTS partners with governments, UN entities, refugee youth-led organisations (RYLOs), civil society, academia, private sector actors, and multi-stakeholder platforms to:

- **Strengthen collaboration and coordinated action** among diverse stakeholders working with and for young people in forced displacement contexts across the humanitarian-development-peace nexus.
- **Generate and disseminate actionable evidence** to inform programming, advocacy, and policies related to forcibly displaced young people's education, skills development, and employment.

¹This is an initiative under the [PROSPECTS Partnership Programme](#), a multi-annual humanitarian-development partnership funded by the Government of the Netherlands that helps transform how host governments and other stakeholders respond to situations of forced displacement. PROSPECTS is implemented by ILO, UNHCR, UNICEF, IFC and the World Bank, operating at global and regional levels, with a focus on eight countries in the Middle East and North and East Africa.



- **Foster dialogue and promote peer learning** across regions and sectors to support institutions to meaningfully engage young people in forced displacement contexts, promoting their access to education, skills development and employment.

The PROSPECTS4Youth Intergenerational Network (IGN) is a key component of the PROSPECTS4Youth Technical Facility (P4YTF) being established under the PROSPECTS Partnership. The P4YTF operates virtually and drives youth engagement, education, skills development, and employment across PROSPECTS countries and pillars by:

LINKING: Connecting key actors working with and for young people in forced displacement contexts with each other and to youth actors more broadly, strengthening multi-stakeholder collaboration, and fostering partnerships to drive evidence-informed advocacy, policies, and programming through the Intergenerational Network (IGN);

LEARNING: Generating, sharing, and applying evidence and knowledge to provide technical assistance focused on advancing skills development, education and pathways to employment in forced displacement contexts;

LOCALISING: Building the skills and capacity of young people in forced displacement contexts and enhancing the institutional capacities of key stakeholders to work with and for young people and strengthen the systems that enable young people's engagement, education, skills development, and employment.

Objectives of the Intergenerational Network Roundtable

The objectives of the roundtable are to:

- Present the PROSPECTS4Youth joint agency work on meaningful youth engagement, skills development, education and employment and share the vision and purpose of the PROSPECTS4Youth Intergenerational Network (IGN).
- Co-design the core elements of the IGN, including thematic priorities, engagement modalities, knowledge-sharing mechanisms.
- Identify stakeholder interest, expertise and ongoing initiatives relevant to young people's education, skills development, and employment in forced displacement contexts to secure early expressions of interest or commitment from organisations to engage in the IGN.
- Outline next steps for the IGN, including priority actions, roles, and a roadmap to help build and launch the IGN.



Expected participants

This round table discussion will bring together implementers and thought leaders working on development approaches to forced displacement to advance young people's engagement, and access to education, skills development and decent work.

Participants include private sector actors, research institutes, foundations, youth-led organisations, and development partners.
