## MYTHOLOGICAL CHARACTERS IN ATHENA'S MAGICAL FLUTE

### Athena

- **In mythology:** A Greek goddess of wisdom, courage, strategy, and crafts. Athena was known for helping heroes, inventing the aulos (a double-reed instrument we call a flute or pipe), and solving problems with intelligence rather than force.
- **In *Dorktales Storytime*:** A talented flute player who grows up on Winter Wonder Island with her best friend Pallas. She values friendship, fairness, and standing up for what is right.

### Zeus

- **In mythology:** The king of the Greek gods who ruled Mount Olympus and controlled thunder and lightning.
- **In *Dorktales Storytime*:** Athena's proud but imperfect father whose desire to see his daughter win leads him to make an unfair choice. He learns the importance of honesty and sportsmanship.

### Pallas

- **In mythology:** In some Greek myths, Pallas was a childhood companion of Athena. Their friendship was very important to Athena's story.
- **In *Dorktales Storytime*:** Daughter of Triton penguin who lives on Winter Wonder Island on Legend Lake. She is Athena's best friend. She loves music, practices hard, and shows courage by returning to the competition after a difficult setback.

## Triton

- **In mythology:** A sea god, often shown as the son of Poseidon and associated with the ocean.
- **In *Dorktales Storytime*:** An emperor penguin who helps raise Athena on Winter Wonder Island and serves as a caring and supportive father figure.
