- Two-year term (March 2024 - March 2026)

Election Timelines and Voting Eligibility

- Timelines:
 - Nominations: Feb 23 - Mar 1, 2024
 - Voting Period: Mar 4 - 6, 2024
 - IHE Canada Chair Announcement: Mar 8, 2024
 - Transition to Chair: Mar 15, 2024
- Voter eligibility: All members of the IHE Canada Community

Voting

- During the voting period, a poll will appear on the InfoCentral home page (in top left corner)
- All results are hidden until the election is complete
- One vote per person
- The winner will be announced on the IHE Community forum and in InfoCentral News
