Meeting Notes

Walkthrough of eReferral Ontario iGuide v0.10.0

- Radhika and Fariba led the walkthrough of the update to the eReferral Ontario iGuide from v0.091 to v0.10
- **if you would like view access of the updated iGuide, please notify Radhika (radhika.verma@ehealthontario.on.ca)**
- Added revision history and known issues pages under 'Home' Tab
- Business Context and Implementation Guidance remain the same
- Profile and Operations has been revamped significantly (the messages are the same but they have been categorized)
 - o All the messages have been moved to Integration Methods sub-tab
- All of the resources are now profiled using Forge
- CapabilityStatement will be updated to be a Forge StructuredDefinition in the coming weeks
- On the terminology page, rows with 2 asterisks in the leftmost column are from the Infoway Terminology Gateway (see the banner at the top of the page)
- Working on a 'delta comparison' spreadsheet between the two iGuide versions to highlight any changes. This will be posted to Basecamp for review and discussion
 - o The entry in the column "Basecamp" reflects both version 0.091 AND the content on basecamp, whatever is more recent
 - o Handful of new resources
 - o In some cases, the old version had an attribute 'struck out' and now they are needed by HSSO
- Approach for discussion will be resource by resource with comments with the corresponding page on Basecamp.
- We could benefit from a repository of questionnaireResponses so there is a library to go to for

others to pick up from

- This can tie-in with the structured data capture work that Joel Francis (Infoway) and Alex Goel (Cancer Care Ontario) are working on

Supporting Further Development of the eReferral iGuide

Yaron provided an proposal of how Ontario can support the progress of the workstream while maintaining alignment with other Ontario digital assets

- Geoff suggested the Standards Council of Canada may be body that may be able to provide Canadian authority
- Tim suggested that we can consider a similar approach to the Argonaut project - the vendors as a consortium
- John suggested creating a delta comparison between the eReferral profiling and Canadian baseline
- Continue to work through the discussion and decision making on Basecamp and then put into Simplifier
- Caryn brings the 'outside of Ontario' perspective so this isn't strictly for Ontario and Alberta Health has being following the progress
