



Employment-Oriented Aliyah for Healthcare Professionals

Kibbutz Or HaNer | 2026–2027

Are you a medical professional looking to build your future in Israel?

The Jewish Agency for Israel, the Ministry of Aliyah and Integration and their department of Physician and Required Medical Professions Directorate, Nefesh B'Nefesh, and the First Home in the Homeland program are excited to invite both Aliyah candidates and new Olim to join a unique program at Kibbutz Or HaNer that combines Aliyah, community integration, Hebrew studies, guidance through the licensing process, and connection to the Israeli healthcare system.

Joining this program provides you with the opportunity to contribute to the Southern region and Gaza Envelope, take part in the region's rehabilitation and growth processes, and bring your knowledge, experience, and professional expertise to Israeli society.

Why join?

The Israeli healthcare system needs high-quality and skilled professionals. This program is designed to help medical professionals integrate into Israel through a structured and supportive pathway, reduce professional uncertainty, and provide tools for future integration into hospitals, HMOs, and other healthcare institutions.

What does the program include?

- Subsidized housing at Kibbutz Or HaNer
- Hebrew studies in an Ulpan setting for approximately five months
- Medical Hebrew Ulpan
- Assistance and guidance through the Ministry of Health's licensing process
- Professional guidance and introductions to the Israeli healthcare system
- Connections with hospitals, health funds, and medical institutions
- Individual and group support
- Absorption within a supportive community framework

Who is the program intended for?

- Aliyah candidates and new Olim from all over the world
- Physicians and Medical Professionals
- Up to age 55
- Looking to participate in Hebrew and medical Hebrew Ulpanim
- Suitability for living in the community at Kibbutz Or HaNer

Please note that acceptance is contingent upon successful completion of an interview conducted by the program team and a document review.

Exceptional cases will be reviewed individually.

The program is limited to **12 participants**.

Housing at Kibbutz Or HaNer

Participants will live in apartments at Kibbutz Or HaNer as part of the First Home in the Homeland program.

Housing options:

- Four-room apartment – NIS 1,900 per month
- Two-room apartment – NIS 1,500 per month

The apartments are suitable for families with up to three children, couples without children, and single participants.

The prices do not include electricity, water, gas, or other potential fees.



Hebrew Studies

Hebrew Ulpan: Approximately five months, five days a week, five hours a day.

Medical Hebrew Ulpan: Approximately three months, five days a week, with an emphasis on professional terminology.

Licensing Process and Professional Integration

Participants will receive guidance during the licensure process according to their profession and the relevant requirements.

During the program, we will also facilitate connections with potential employers, including:

- Hospitals
- Health funds
- Medical centers
- Healthcare institutions

This is intended to help each participant build a clear professional pathway for continued integration into the Israeli healthcare system once the program concludes.

Key Dates

- Make Aliyah by: by December 2026
- Hebrew Ulpan begins: December 2026 – May 2027
- Medical Hebrew begins: May 2027
- Professional guidance and assistance with employment integration\exam preparation\observation\internship: September 2027

Now is the time to turn your professional experience and knowledge into a meaningful career in Israel. Combined with value-driven action, contribution to the community, and strengthening the southern region and the Gaza Envelope, this is an opportunity you don't want to miss!
