

Summary Notes:

- It was noted that:
 - Nine additional tools were extracted to date including the Williams Major, “Everyday Discrimination Scale, which the group has been discussing over the past two sessions.
 - A systematic review with a population focus was conducted. The group will be focusing on two population scales: Asian American Racism-Related Stress Inventory (AARRSI) and Measure of Indigenous Racism Experiences (MIRE) scales.
 - Most of scales are dated (prior to 2010), except for the Intersectional Scale, which is 2 years old

- The group was asked what we should focus on for 2022 and suggested:
 - Include Adolescent-focused index
 - Consider how disability is being brought into these scales
 - Glean message from the authors looking for overlapping themes
 - No need to go through every instrument of the review
 - Group will carry on with current work and format, with a focus on Intersectional Scale
 - Intersectional work would benefit the work of CIHI

- The review of the Williams Major, Everyday Discrimination Scale was discussed

Next steps:

- Possible next tools to focus on: Adolescent scales
- Look at what the authors of the systematic review suggested as being useful to focus on
- Grouping overlap of the concepts across the different scales
- For our next meeting we will look at racism and discrimination scales specific to Indigenous populations (MIRE and In Plain Sight Report).
