# YOUTH ADVISORY GROUP ON DIGITAL JOBS

## CALL FOR PARTICIPATION

The Youth Advisory Group on Digital Jobs is a unique platform that will bring together young leaders, youth-led organisations, and technical experts from across Côte d'Ivoire, Egypt, Ethiopia, Kenya, Nigeria, Rwanda, Senegal, South Africa and Uganda to discuss, design and shape solutions to improve access to digital employment opportunities for young people in Africa.

To be considered for the Youth Advisory Group, youth members should be:

- 1 Aged 18 to 29.
- 2 From one of the nine priority countries.
- 3 Studying, working, or volunteering on projects or initiatives that support digital skills development and employment opportunities for young people in the digital economy.
- 4 Part of an existing community or network with other young people, with who they can engage in outreach and dialogue on the topic.
- 5 Available to participate in three online co-design workshops between October and December 2022.
