## **Sex Parameter for Clinical Use (SPCU) (Required binding, select one)**

A summary parameter that provides guidance on how a receiver should apply settings or reference ranges that are derived from observable information such as an organ inventory, recent hormone lab tests, genetic testing, menstrual status, obstetric history, etc.

- Apply female-typical setting or reference range; Code: Female-typical
  - Synonym: Female sex for clinical use
  - Available data indicates that diagnostics, analytics, and treatments should consider best practices associated with female reference populations.
- Apply male-typical setting or reference range; Code: Male-typical
  - Synonym: Male sex for clinical use
  - Available data indicates that diagnostics, analytics, and treatments should consider best practices associated with male reference populations.
- Apply specified setting or reference range; Code: Specified
  - Available data indicates that diagnostics, analytics, and treatment best practices may be undefined or not aligned with sex-derived reference populations. Additional information (usually, but not always, in the form of comments and/or observations) may be available.
- Unknown clinical parameter setting or reference range; Code: UNK (Null Flavor)
  - No pertinent data available.
