About the campus

Tzuba is a beautiful kibbutz located in the Jerusalem mountains, close to both Tel Aviv and Jerusalem. The ulpan participants in Tzuba are like family, and the kibbutz emphasizes the value of community life and the relationship between the kibbutz members and the ulpan. Etzion Tzuba takes Hebrew studies seriously and this is a great place to learn how to speak Hebrew like a true Israeli!



Costs

Track one:
Classic Ulpan 6,200 NIS

Track two:
Paid work outside the kibbutz at the responsibility of the candidate, 3 days ulpan, 3 days work - 12400 NIS.

Accommodation and food

Participants live in shared rooms, with two participants in each room. Each room includes a small fridge, AC, desk, chairs, and Free Wi-Fi. Towels, bedsheets, and blankets are provided. The women's rooms have an attached bathroom. The men have a shared bathroom. Each participant receives a monthly meal allowance. With this allowance, you can choose to either buy a meal at the Kibbutz dining hall (available on certain days) or buy food at the shop on the Kibbutz, or you can buy products and cook your meal. The afternoons and evenings are your spare time! You can enjoy the local pub, exercise at the gym (which may require additional cost), or just relax and enjoy the amazing views of Tzuba.
