3.	<p>RFCs update</p> <p>Feedback on COMIRNATY Omicron XBB.1.5 pediatric vaccines - naming conventions:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Decision was made to post on Forum with Ontario's suggestion (diluent) for distinguishing these vaccines from one another and seek feedback from stakeholders. Timeline will be a week for members to provide other options/suggestions. Infoway will meet internally w SNOMED CT experts to see if they have suggestions. Confirmed that patient age would not work in this case as the products are indicated for the same age group. Cap color was not advisable due to potential for error. Infoway will review the editorial guidelines to see if updates are required for the preferred term.
