5. Use Case Discussion – Sex Parameter for Clinical Use (SPCU) and Anatomic Inventories

Some of the discussion points:

- Use of SPCU and/or anatomic inventories may prevent harmful questions up front and/or help with transitions to new care providers
- Use case has a variety of pronouns, which illustrates the need to capture this within the record so clinicians/staff can use the appropriate pronouns in encounters
- potential for giving rationale for medications – may not be an intended use of SPCU, but might be used in this way by clinicians
- Theoretically, SPCU could be used on any type of order, may need guidelines for use
- Question about how it might apply to procedures rather than orders
- Ongoing question about who is responsible for data collection for organ inventories and the update frequency, how will information within the inventory be exchanged
