

Summary of the measures reviewed over the past year

- Categorization of the measures includes sub-domains, social identities, setting, unfair action, and response to the unfair action
- Figures were presented on how to conceptualize:
 - the intersection of identity, setting, racist action and requesting inequities
 - how racism and discrimination intersect with material hardship/material circumstances and healthcare access
 - strength-based approach

The Gravity Project

- Dr. Sarah DeSilvey presented on the Gravity Project:

- There are 2000+ members registered and regularly get 200 people attending the meetings.
- The importance of strong data governance and data justice due to the sensitivity of SDOH data
- The terms of reference are referenced each time a new domain is being developed by cross referencing the principles and risks.
- There is a current gap in intervention terminology
- Regularly meets with international standards groups (e.g., SNOMED) and welcomes bringing more Canadian perspectives into these discussions.
- Will be looking at 'racism, discrimination and bias' in 2023.
