2	COVID-19 Terminology Discussion	<p>COVID-19 terminology updates since last meeting</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">Medicago trade name and generic COVID-19 virus-like particle generic concepts created (see hierarchy below). <p>Question: what should the shelf status be for upcoming COVID vaccines not yet on the market?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">Melanie Reed (Health Canada) has consulted with colleagues and recommends using the term "Under review" for products not yet approved by Health Canada but have a SNOMED-CT concept created (e.g. Medicago, Novavax).For approved COVID-19 products that are not yet marketed, Health Canada recommends using "Authorized by Interim Order" (e.g. Janssen).The CVC will use the terms "Under review" for products not yet approved. For those approved/marketed, we will use terminology consistent with the Drug Product Database. If stakeholders have any questions or concerns with this approach, we ask that you let us know by June 11th. <p>Question: should we be submitting RFCs for COVID-19 vaccines administered outside of Canada?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">A group at SNOMED International where countries are listing what they're using as terminology as part of a community edition project. This project could potentially be leveraged.CVC and stakeholders to connect offline to determine path forward <p>Question: Any other stakeholder needs for COVID-19 terminology?</p>	Taylor/group discussion
