Where is the appropriate forum for vendor engagement in the national strategy, especially with new referral working groups and jurisdictional discussions?

The current working group meetings will remain the forum for vendor engagement. The strategy involves gathering feedback from different provinces and territories and bringing these discussions, including vendor-related topics, back to the working group.

Will process flow diagrams be ready for the next meeting?

The next steps for updating the described use cases involve developing jurisdictional flow diagrams to overlay on the existing workflows. We are currently planning meetings with the relevant jurisdictions and will provide updates to the working group as we progress through this process.
