

# Wireless Screen Mirror Projection with ConferenceCam Connect



ConferenceCam Connect provides a wireless connection that enables the projection of screen content from a mobile device<sup>1</sup> to a television, projector, monitor or other display with HDMI input.

Screen mirroring<sup>2</sup> makes it quick and easy to share mobile content (like websites, presentations, and calendars) with all meeting participants.

## Here's how:

- Connect an HDMI cable between ConferenceCam Connect and your projector, monitor, television or other display
  - Select **Screen Mirroring Mode** on ConferenceCam Connect (the display will typically change to the correct HDMI input, but if not, simply select the correct HDMI input)
  - From phone or tablet, go to **Settings**
  - Select your phone or tablet's option for screen mirroring. The listed option name will differ from **device to device. Select** ConferenceCam Connect.
- The mobile device will connect and **begin sharing content** to the projector, monitor, television or other display
- To share content in **full screen**, simply orient the phone or tablet horizontally
  - By default, audio will stream from the display, if audio enabled. If your mobile device is paired via Bluetooth to ConferenceCam Connect when you start screen mirroring, the speakerphone on ConferenceCam Connect will handle the audio



# Screen Mirroring with **ConferenceCam Connect**

## ConferenceCam Connect supports Miracast for screen mirroring

Note that different mobile devices use different names and paths for screen mirroring. Phone/tablet manufacturers may even use different names and paths from device to device (as with Samsung Galaxy). Please check with the phone/tablet manufacturer for any mobile device-specific questions.

Here is a partial list of specific mobile devices and their paths for screen mirroring:
