➤ Antigen Code Valueset

- Removed: 52821000087108 | Vaccine product containing only Neisseria meningitidis serogroup A capsular polysaccharide conjugated antigen (medicinal product)
- Replaced by: 871834006 | Antigen of Neisseria meningitidis serogroup A capsular polysaccharide conjugated (substance)

➤ SNOMED CT:

- Substance hierarchy : concepts for **individual** active ingredients of pharmaceutical products
- Terms referring to multiple substances **not allowed** in the substance hierarchy
 - Term referring to multiple medicinal substances is considered a pharmaceutical product

The Pan-Canadian Health Data Content Framework

What is it?



One comprehensive data content standard with common data architecture for all health-related data in one place.

Purpose



Improve the quality and consistency of health data captured and shared across Canada. Its purpose is broad and includes interoperability.

Features



• One content standard	Includes data elements, value sets and common data architecture
• Person-centric	Prioritizes the individual in the data design
• Pan-Canadian	Comparable across all health systems
• Sector-agnostic	Applies to patient care regardless of sector
• Comprehensive	Includes data for clinical care and health system use (i.e., health research, population and public health surveillance, and health system management).
• Built-in maturity	Levels 0 to 3 indicate maturity of products for use
• Bilingual	Available in English and French

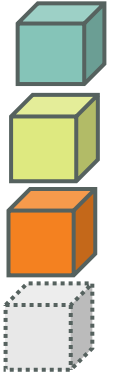

Pan-Canadian Health Data Content Framework

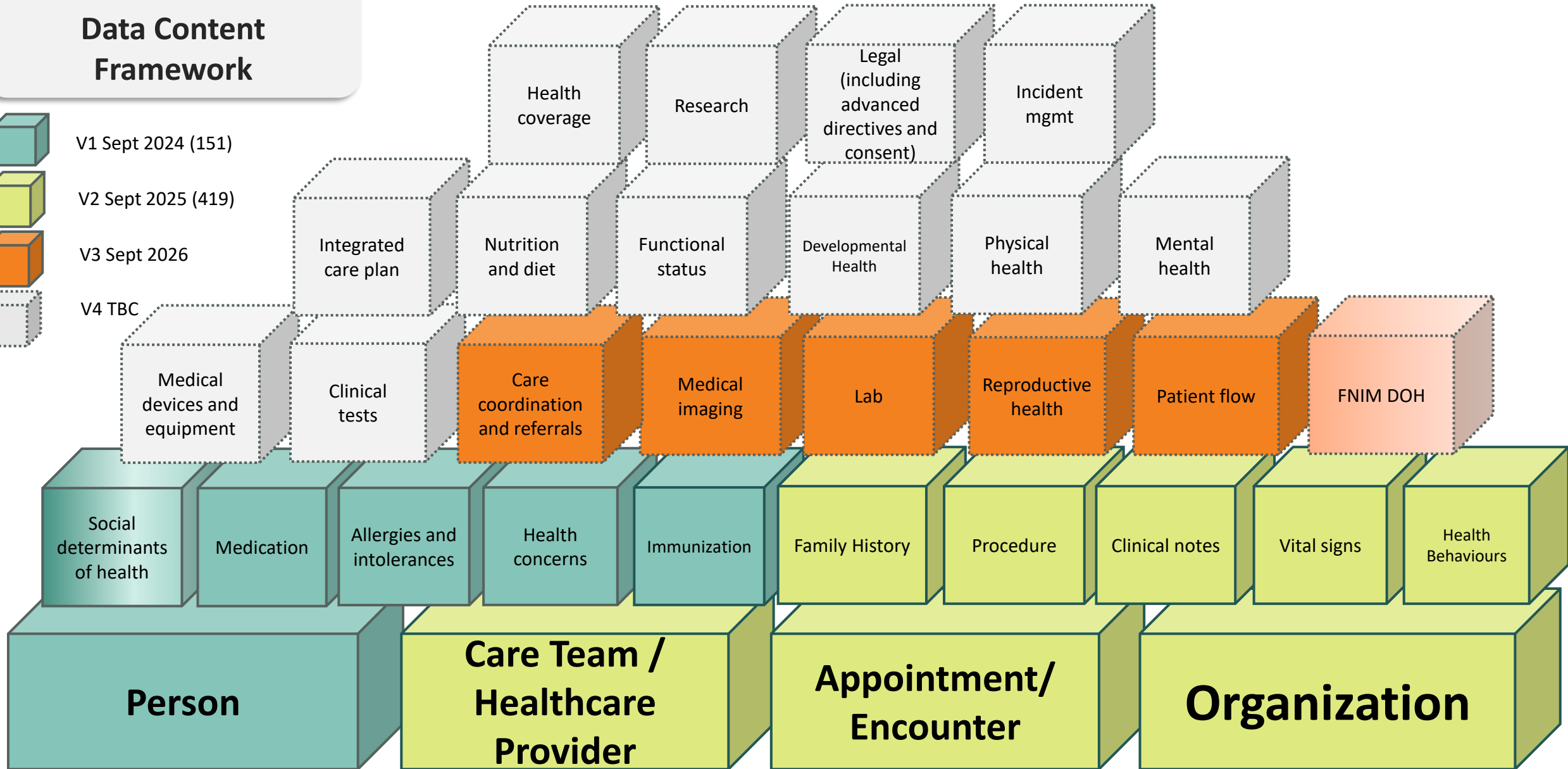

Data element	Data element definition	Recommended value set and examples	Feedback
Immunization Reporting Source	The source of information reporting the immunization event (e.g., person, health care provider)	ImmunizationReportingSourceCode <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Computer record of patient• Health care professional• Person Note: This is the full value set.	“Not sure if this should include fax or paper record as some First Nations, rural or remote communities are still fax or paper based.”

Questions for the PHS Community:

1. Is this value set in use in your jurisdiction? If not, we propose to rename the value set to a more general ReportingSourceCode for reuse across the Pan-Canadian Health Data Content Framework.
2. Are there any concerns with broadening the concept for ‘computer record of patient’ to more generally represent a patient record (the format is less important in this context, e.g., computer versus paper-based records)?

Immunization– Open review feedback

Data element	Data element definition	Recommended value set and examples	Feedback
Immunization Reason	The reason why the immunization product was administered (i.e., routine immunization, high-risk immunization)	ActImmunizationReason <ul style="list-style-type: none">• High-risk immunization• Routine immunization Note: This is the full value set.	“Suggest including option for self-selection of the vaccine outside of routine and high-risk categorization.”

Question for the PHS Community: Are there expanded immunization reason value sets in use within the provinces/territories that include other options for immunization reasons?

Note – this also came up during the first open review and was discussed with the PHS community. A suggestion was made to add an ‘non-publicly funded immunization’ option to capture these additional use cases
