Seven successful hydrogen hubs | USA




The Biden administration [announced plans on Friday](#) to award up to \$7 billion to create seven regional hubs around the country that will make and use hydrogen, a clean-burning fuel with the potential to power ships or factories without producing any planet-warming emissions.

Hydrogen can be produced without creating any greenhouse gases.

By awarding these grants, the Biden administration is trying to stand up an entire industry from scratch.





Regions competed for the money, which will be awarded to proposed hydrogen projects on the Gulf Coast (Texas and Louisiana) and in the Mid-Atlantic (Pennsylvania, Delaware and New Jersey), Appalachia (Pennsylvania, West Virginia and Ohio), the Midwest (Illinois, Indiana and Michigan), the Upper Midwest (Minnesota, North Dakota and South Dakota) and the Pacific Northwest (Washington, Oregon and Montana).

A proposed hub in California will also receive funding.
