## Updates/Administration

1. Smart on FHIR - will keep on the same basecamp site as eReferrals for now
2. Timing for publishing the iGuide - 2 phases:
  - a. Pilot integration to test if the iGuide is production ready (Oct 2018)
  - b. iGuide ready to support full integration (April 2019)
- eHealth Ontario will stylize the eReferral iGuide so that it follows the same layout and contains the same level of content as the [Ontario Provincial Client Registry](#). Target delivery: October 2018

## Discussion Item: *Appointment Resource*

- Bug in Simplifier.net - **need to select Appointment(temp) to export/download**
- *Text.div* - text friendly version of the full appointment
- The resource is designed to 'map' to an Outlook type of meeting invite in terms of the fields. Tim has included the 'mapping' in the description
- *Description* = meeting topic/subject in outlook
- *basedOn* (formerly called 'IncomingReferral') - this will reference the ServiceRequest that led to the Appointment. It is where all of the relevant clinical info can be retrieved from
- *Participant* - this is mandatory.
- **DECISION:** even though the Appointment is referring the ServiceRequest, since the Appointment may be sent to the patient once it is booked, it makes sense that this resource should contain all the info required (e.g. location, practitioner) without relying on the Service Request (or Communication resources) being sent.
  
- Potential change request to the resource: the location and healthcare service should be distinct actor from the *Participant.actor* (in the 'change request submissions')
- What does *Participant.actor* = device refer to? might represent that a device might be needed/used (e.g. telemedicine, ultrasound/MRI, glucose monitor)
- *AppointmentType* - the current value set (based on HL7 v2) is missing a code that would cover 'intake or assessment'
  - o **DECISION:** exclude because it doesn't seem to have a useful value (what would the requestor use this info for/?)
- The *Participant.actor.required* and *Participant.actor.status* are both necessary to ensure that any people or devices that are necessary to make a meeting successful are 'allocated/booked'.
- **DECISION:** will not profile RelatedPerson resource at this point.
